GA/B/F2018-004 A Bill to Require Cultural Competence among USG Representatives Wednesday, December 5, 2018

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF KENT STATE UNIVERSITY AT KENT CAMPUS:

Section 1. Amend Section III of USG Bylaws

Section III of the USG Bylaws defines the Responsibilities of the Undergraduate Student Government Executive Cabinet. The passage of this bill will add the following requirement: "S. Must become Green Dot certified in the Power-Based Personal Violence workshop, and have completed The Basics of Building Culturally Competent Communication Skills workshop offered by the Division of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion, preferably by the start of the academic term, during the training week."

Section 2. Amendment to Section V of USG Bylaws

Section V of the USG Bylaws defines the Responsibilities of the Undergraduate Student Government Senators. The passage of this bill will add the following requirement: "S. Must become Green Dot certified in the Power-Based Personal Violence workshop, and have completed The Basics of Building Culturally Competent Communication Skills workshop offered by the Division of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion, preferably by the start of the academic term, during the training week."

Section 3. Rationale

As compensated student leaders entrusted to represent the entirety of the undergraduate student body, USG Representatives should be culturally competent

in their leadership style(s). USG Representatives must also be competent in the aspects of power based personal violence.

Adopted by the 2018-2019 General Assembly on December 9, 2018.
