Resolution of Support for the Implementation of a Food Waste Mitigation Program

Whereas, the Dining Services of Kent State University has created new meal plans primarily using buffet style dining instead of declining balance; and

Whereas, dining systems like these at have an immense amount of food waste that is being disposed of in the trash; and

Whereas, a solution to reduce the amount of food related waste would be to start a composting or similar food waste reduction program; and

Whereas, composting is beneficial because it reduces methane emissions from landfills and lowers the carbon footprint¹; and

Whereas, many other collegiate institutions already have composting programs in place like University of California: Davis which composts 98% of its organic waste³; and

Whereas, the Office of Sustainability works to increase sustainability in university operations as well as collaborating with faculty to incorporate sustainability across the curriculum²; and

Whereas, Kent State University needs to set the example of what effective environmental stewardship looks for its students and other collegiate institutions; and

Therefore, let it be resolved by the Undergraduate Student Government, Kent Campus, acting in full session, that Undergraduate Student Government:

- 1. Expresses its support and is encouraging the implementation of a composting program in conjunction with local organizations like 4H.
- 2. Recommends seeking grant funding for an on campus facility.
